

Contracted Student Services

The Board of Trustees hereby delegates to the Director of Special Services the authority to enter into agreements for student services but requires District approval of such contracts.

The Board of Trustees may contract for special services from another school district, approved rehabilitation center or hospital or corporation approved by the State Board of Education at a cost not to exceed the state and county funds for the education of the student as described in Idaho Code 33-1002 and 33-1405.

The Trustees may contract with other agencies but all contracts must be approved by the State Department of Education in advance.

The contracts must be on forms adopted by the State Board of Education.

The contract, to be valid, must be initiated with the director of special services and signed by the Superintendent of Schools.

Special Education

It is the intent of the District to provide services required by students' Individualized Educational Programs (IEPs) and develop resources within the District to decrease the need for outside sources for special education services.
