

Student Publications

The official school publications such as school newspapers would reflect the policy and judgment of the student editors. Students have the responsibility to refrain from libel and obscenity and to observe the normal rules for reasonable journalism. Within these bounds students have a responsibility to report the news in a professional manner.

Any school newspaper must have a faculty advisor in grades 9 through 12 and supervision at any other grade level. No unauthorized newspaper may be published or disseminated on school district property.
