

Medical Treatment Training

First Aid and CPR

The policy of the Board of Trustees is that each employee in the following job categories/titles shall be trained in First Aid treatment and shall hold a current First Aid card which shall include adult and child CPR. First aid and CPR cards should be renewed every two years.

1. Industrial and Culinary Arts and Health Occupations Teachers
2. Physical Education Teachers
3. Junior-, Middle-, and High-School Science Teachers
4. Coaches and Activities/Athletic Directors
5. Principals
6. School Nurses and Nursing Assistants/Aides
7. Building/School Office Coordinators
8. Child Nutrition Personnel
9. Transportation Personnel
10. Special Services Paraprofessionals and Aides
11. Duty Free Aides & Crossing Guards

All new employees in these categories are required to have a current First aid and CPR (Adult and Child) card within 90 days of employment.

Bloodborne Pathogens

All employees in the District shall be trained in handling bodily fluids within 90 days of hire and annually thereafter.

Cost of Training

Required training, and any expense for training, will be provided by the District.
