

Emergency, Disaster, and Crisis Preparedness

The Board recognizes the importance of being prepared for various types of emergencies, both natural and human, that could occur while school is in session. This necessitates the need to develop appropriate plans and procedures to deal with such emergencies at school facilities or involving school transport. It is important that students, employees and parents be knowledgeable about the various emergency plans and procedures and to be prepared should such an emergency occur.

Crisis Response Plan

The School District will maintain a Crisis Response Plan to act as a guide for school district board members, administration, staff, students, parents, and community members to respond to an emergency, disaster, and/or crisis, in the school district.

Each principal and site manager shall receive a copy of the Crisis Response Plan and shall provide in-service training on plan implementation.

The district Crisis Response Plan serves as the foundation for the development, training, and implementation of individual site/program plans.
